Data Resources for Economic Development

The following list of resources is not exhaustive and is updated on an ongoing basis. "New" simply indicates information that was added since the last distribution.

General:

- Alberta Regional Dashboard: This tool helps answer your questions about living, working, investing, and doing
 business in Alberta's diverse regions. Through this dashboard you can view your community's data, build custom
 regions to compile data as well as embed the information onto your website. Please contact me if you would like

- <u>Alberta Economic Dashboard</u>: Compilation of the Alberta economy's most important indicators of businesses in one place. Get a quick snapshot of Alberta's current economic state or explore each indicator in more detail.
- Alberta Site Selector Tool: The Alberta Site Selector Tool is a self-serve digital platform that helps businesses and investors find and evaluate suitable properties to expand or locate their business in communities across Alberta. This user-friendly tool empowers users by providing advanced filtering options that combine available property listings with insights on local economic conditions, industry data and proximity to crucial infrastructure.
- Alberta Municipal Dashboards: Use the municipal data and statistics section to look up contact details of
 government officials, learn how to conduct a census, and compare financial information between different
 communities. You can also find documents, maps, and other resources about the boundaries and location of Alberta
 municipalities.
- NEW <u>GoA Office of Statistics and Information (OSI)</u>: This office plans, consolidates, develops and promotes Alberta's demographic, economic, social and other statistics.
- <u>Rural Canada Statistics Portal:</u> The Rural and Small-Town Canada dashboard aims to offer comprehensive insights into the dynamic social, economic and environmental landscape and includes five interactive dashboards focused on (1) the number and size of communities, (2) business counts, (3) business conditions, (4) trade, and (5) employment insurance beneficiaries.

- <u>Alberta Industry Profiles:</u> Demographics estimated wages and employment trends are highlighted in profiles of 18 major Alberta industries below.
