- **310-FARM** – The first point of contact for Agriculture and Irrigation's programs and resources. 310-FARM resource agents are available to assist with inquiries or refer to the appropriate department or industry resource (www.alberta.ca/310-farm).

- **Alberta.ca Account** – Provides Albertans with a common, secure and streamlined way to access more than 70 digital and online government services, including those from non-Government of Alberta organizations like Alberta Health Services, Service Canada and the Canada Revenue Agency (www.alberta.ca/alberta-ca-account-for-personal-use).
- **Alberta.ca Account for Organizations** – Allows a business/organization to create an account and delegate access to its staff, avoiding the need to rely on a personal Alberta.ca Account for business transactions (www.alberta.ca/alberta-ca-account-for-business-use).
- A **General Inquiries Portal** has been added to the Alberta government website to direct inquiries – now automatically routed to the Ministry Inboxes (www.alberta.ca/general-inquiries).
- **CyberAlberta** – Provides Alberta-based public and private organizations with cyber threat information, advice, knowledge and resources to help them stay ahead of ever-evolving cyber threats (www.cyberalberta.ca).
- **eServices** – A common eCommerce portal that streamlines Albertans' online access to a wide range of government services, including licenses, permits and certificates. It provides a consistent, secure and convenient online experience for citizens, while supporting ministries in their transition to digital service delivery. The platform continues to expand, serving as a unified gateway for accessing and purchasing government services (eservices.alberta.ca/).

- **Innovation Employment Grant** – Supports small- and medium-sized businesses that invest in research and development with a grant worth up to 20 per cent of qualifying expenditures (www.alberta.ca/innovation-employment-grant.aspx).

- **Alberta Advantage Immigration Program** – An economic immigration program for foreign nationals and entrepreneurs seeking permanent residency in Alberta (www.alberta.ca/alberta-advantage-immigration-program).
- **Settlement, Integration and Language Project grants** – Funding for projects that respond to emerging settlement needs such as system improvement, capacity building and labour market attachment (www.alberta.ca/settlement-integration-language-projects-grants).
- **Supports for Newcomer Integration grants** – Funding for services like settlement support, language assessment and referral and drop-in English as an Additional Language programs to help newcomers in Alberta achieve their full economic potential (www.alberta.ca/supports-for-newcomer-integration-grants).

- **Aboriginal Business Investment Fund** – Helps Indigenous community-owned businesses capitalize on development opportunities to improve socio-economic outcomes (www.alberta.ca/aboriginal-business-investment-fund).
- **Alberta Indigenous Opportunities Corporation** – Created by the government to serve as a catalyst for Indigenous communities to access capital for mid-to large scale projects and to grow independent prosperity (theaioc.com).
- **Indigenous Employment Training Partnerships** – Provides grant funding to Indigenous communities and organizations to deliver group-training projects designed in partnership with employers and other partners (www.alberta.ca/indigenous-employment-training-partnerships-program).
- **Indigenous Reconciliation Initiative (Economic Stream)** – Funds Indigenous-led capacity and opportunity development projects that improve economic outcomes for communities (www.alberta.ca/indigenous-reconciliation-initiative).

Investment

- **Alberta Agri-Processing Investment Tax Credit** – Supporting investments of at least \$10 million to build or expand value-added agri-processing facilities (www.alberta.ca/alberta-agri-processing-investment-tax-credit).
- **Alberta Enterprise Corporation** – A provincial corporation that supports economic diversification by investing in venture capital funds that in turn invest in Alberta technology companies (www.alberta-enterprise.ca/).
- **Alberta Innovates** – A provincial corporation that supports research, development and commercialization of new innovations and technologies through funding programs and community-based Regional Innovation Networks. Two wholly owned subsidiaries, InnoTech Alberta Inc. and C-FER Technologies, provide applied research services (albertainnovates.ca).
- **Alberta Petrochemicals Incentive Program** - Provides grants to companies to attract investment in new or expanded market-driven petrochemical facilities (www.alberta.ca/alberta-petrochemicals-incentive-program).
- **Alberta Site Selector Tool** – A tool to help site selectors locate properties within the province that is enriched with advanced filtering capabilities, insights on local economic conditions, industry data and proximity to crucial infrastructures (siteselector.alberta.ca).
- **Alberta's AI Data Centre Strategy** – The Government of Alberta's strategy for attracting AI data centre investment to the province (www.alberta.ca/artificial-intelligence-data-centres-strategy).

- **Emerging Resources Program** – Provides benefits in the form of a fixed royalty rate to qualified applicants of this program. Companies that develop new oil and gas resources in high risk and high cost areas are provided with high drilling and completion cost allowances, thereby providing them the benefit of paying a lower royalty rate until they recoup these costs (www.alberta.ca/emerging-resources-program).
- **Enhanced Hydrocarbon Recovery Program** – Provides benefits in the form of a fixed royalty rate to qualified applicants that use enhanced recovery techniques for oil and gas resources remaining in the legacy fields. Depending on the recovery method used and the estimated amount of oil and gas resource that can be recovered, the program can provide benefit to the recipient up to a maximum of 90 months (www.alberta.ca/enhanced-hydrocarbon-recovery-program).
- **Invest Alberta Corporation (IAC)** – A Crown corporation established in 2020, IAC engages the world and provides high-end tailored support to companies, investors and major new projects (investalberta.ca).
- **Investment and Growth Fund (IGF)** – Alberta's government supports high value, private sector, job-creating investments and drives economic growth and diversification through a \$15-million annual commitment to the IGF. The IGF is an invite-only deal-closing incentive, designed to be offered to select new investments or expansions in the later stages of decision making where there is a demonstrable barrier to making a final investment decision in Alberta (email program information contact: igf.program@gov.ab.ca).
